## Summer Camps 2026

2 week sessions are Monday-Thursday,

1 week sessions are Monday-Friday.

Both are 8:00 am - 4:00 pm.

- Plant Camp!**: 1 week only, June 1-5. \$325/child.
  - Age group: Preschool-focused, with older siblings up to 7 years old
  - Themes and activities include: Freeplay, plant I.D., taking care of seedlings, gardening and foraging, preparing and operating a plant sale fundraiser on Friday June 5.
  
- Midsummer Camp**: 2 weeks long, June 22-July 2. \$520/child.
  - Age group: Preschool-focused, with older siblings up to 7 years old
  - Themes and activities include: Freeplay, hiking, outdoor cooking, creek and river exploration, aquatic invertebrate catching, art, music, etc.
  
- July Camp**: 2 weeks long, July 20-30. \$520/child.
  - Age group: Elementary-focused, 6-11 years old, with some flexibility.
  - Themes and activities include: focus on creative ventures, variety of art projects, clay harvesting/processing/sculpting, outdoor cooking, and river swimming.
  
- August Adventures Camp**: 1 week only, August 10-14. \$325/child.
  - Age group: Preschool-focused, with siblings and alumni up to 7 years old. A great opportunity to reunite, relax, and play!
  - Themes and activities include: outdoor play and exploration, music, gardening and foraging, water play, hiking, art projects, etc.

We have limited space in our summer camps and they fill up quickly. We wish we could offer more and accept everyone into whichever camps they want! Sadly we cannot. We are seeking other folks interested in offering youth summer programming who would like to use our facility (background check and training required, so would need to start the process ASAP), let us know if you want to talk about these options, and please spread the word to anyone who might be interested!

**Enrollment Priorities for Summer Camps are generally as follows:**

- **Plant Camp & Midsummer Camp:** Current preschool children have first priority, current preschool siblings have second priority, KP alumni have third priority.
- **2nd July Camp:** Past July Camp enrollees have 1st priority, KP alumni and their siblings have 2nd priority, then current preschoolers.
- **August Camp:** Preschool families for the 2026-27 school year have 1st priority, current preschoolers have 2nd priority, KP alumni have 3rd priority.
- If you are interested in a summer camp for your child, but they are outside of the listed age range, please let us know. These age ranges are flexible if space allows.

**When you send us the application email, list the camps for which you are applying in order of your preference. Reminder- email [KINDREDPATHSLLC@GMAIL.COM](mailto:KINDREDPATHSLLC@GMAIL.COM) with subject line “Summer Camp 2026” to apply for spots in any of these camps.**

**The initial deadline for applying for summer camps is January 31st. We will begin to let families know what summer camps they are accepted to the following week. One exception to this is for the August Camp - that session we will wait to send acceptances until next school year’s enrollment is set around February 20th.**

**A deposit of \$100 will be due one week after acceptances are sent out. This deposit will go towards your child’s first summer camp tuition. Further instructions will be provided on how we will collect those deposits.**
